



APSconnect

APSconnect is a case management and reporting system for Adult Protective Services cases. This comprehensive system allows APS units to track, manage and report cases of abuse or neglect. By associating victims, perpetrators, and complainants to a case(s), investigators have the ability to review all cases linked to an associated person. This association allows case workers to analyze trends with case participants. APS investigators can easily view and manage their cases through a Smart Client interface over the Internet.

Features of the APSconnect software is:

- Highly secure Smart Client architecture
- Centralized data storage
- Full case management for multiple APS units
- Statewide view of perpetrators and victims
- Links individuals across cases between units
- Unit and Statewide reporting of statistics
- State level oversight of data
- Case notes
- Case attachments (documents and images)

INITIAL INTAKE

Simple, easy to use intake interface allows users to efficiently enter abuse reports while the complainant is on the telephone. The detailed intake screen records the case information, people associated with each case, free form comments, and file attachments.

Intake - Detailed and easy to use intake screen records case type, status, severity, case dates, case reference numbers, allegations, findings, action type, location, facility, physician, and associated people.

With just a click of a button, APSconnect allows users with the appropriate security permissions to easily assign and reassign cases to APSconnect system users.

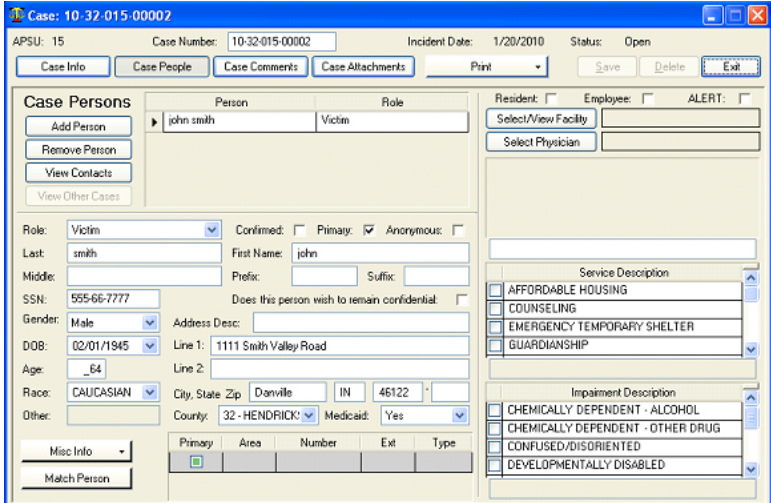
CASE MANAGEMENT

The people associated with a case or many cases can be easily tracked for analysis depending on their role: victim, alleged perpetrator or complainant. If users have the appropriate security permissions, case managers can view cases for victims or perpetrators statewide.

Adding Participants to a Case - APScconnect's robust search engine provides users with the capability to search previously entered case participants and allows the user to select the

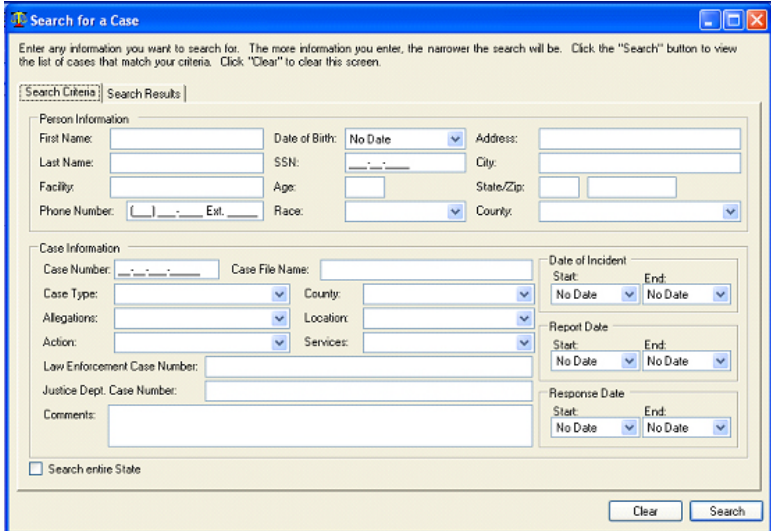
By clicking on Misc Info, identifying Characteristics describing a person can be added, such as a tattoo, height and weight along with drivers license number can also be added.

APScconnect's matching feature accounts for name aliases by allowing users to indicate that a participant is the same person as another listing in the system.
